An English course at the minimum grade 12 level¹ (Canadian or equivalent) 	<p>Submit a copy of transcripts from all secondary and post-secondary institutions attended. If post-secondary transcripts show all required academic prerequisites, the secondary transcript is not required.</p> <p>Only education completed within Canada, or its equivalent, will be considered. If you completed your education outside of Canada, you must verify and validate the education through services such as the World Education Services.</p> <p>¹Applicants who do not have a minimum of Canadian grade 12 English must show proof of English proficiency. Please review the Language Requirements drop-down on the website for a list of accepted English proficiency tests/scores.</p>
